

- Every school day begins and ends with prayer

- 30% of our student body participate in a Mission Trip each year
- Financial Assistance is available to ensure all students who wish to take part in a Mission Trip are able to participate

SERVICE

- 80 hours of community service required for graduation
- Students also participate in numerous school wide service projects, including hosting a mobile food pantry, sponsoring families for Thanksgiving and Christmas, and various collections throughout the year for local charities
- Work-a-Thon is our annual day of service in which students, staff, and parents spend the morning volunteering in the greater Lansing area
